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Actuarial valuation 2025 update

We'll be holding an Employer Valuation Forum on 11 December 2025, attended by the Fund's actuary, which will include the launch of a consultation on our new Funding Strategy Statement.

The Forum will be held virtually and we'll be in touch in the coming weeks with further details.

i-Connect and Contribution return (CR1) forms

Most of our employers are now sending monthly data to us through i-Connect. The deadline for <u>i-Connect</u> submissions is the same as your contributions payment and CR1 form deadline which is the 19th of the following month.

For example, your October 2025 contributions payment, CR1 and i-Connect submission must be received by us no later than 19 November 2025.

In months where you expect to trigger tolerances on i-Connect you should allow yourself additional time in the month to resolve any errors ahead of the 19th deadline. For example, when you have experienced a high number of new starters.

We are looking into streamlining the process for i-Connect and CR1 submissions after the valuation has been completed. When this has been finalised, we will share further details with you. Until then, please continue to send CR1 forms by the monthly deadline.



Tip: To help reduce queries, please ensure your CR1 form and i-Connect file reconcile before you submit them to the Fund.



Updates to your Authorised Signatories and Employer Discretions Policy

III-health retirement

III-health risk management

The Fund's current approach to ill health risk management means that <u>shortfall costs</u> in respect of ill health early retirements are not immediately payable by the employer (unlike certain other forms of early retirement such as redundancy).

The ill-health retirement liabilities will be considered at the next triennial valuation and may result in an adjustment to your funding position and employer contribution rate.

The ill health risk management page on our website provides further information on:

- how an ill health retirement shortfall cost is worked out
- the impact on your funding position and employer contribution rate
- information about how to mitigate the risk with an external ill health insurance policy which can be arranged through the Fund's actuary, Hymans Robertson LLP
- how to contact Hymans Robertson LLP, to obtain a quotation for cost of the insurance

III-health process

Employers no longer need to inform the Fund of any changes to their list of medical practitioners due to recent updates to our medical certificates.

In the latest versions of our medical certificates, employers authorise the medical practitioner on completion of the relevant declaration.

Please ensure when considering an ill-health retirement application that you are using the latest version which is available on our website.

LGPS consultation: Scheme Improvements (Access and Protections)

We issued an email on 22 October 2025 to our main contact at each employer about a new consultation opened by the Ministry of Housing, Communities and Local Government (MHCLG): LGPS: Scheme improvements (access and protections) consultation.

The consultation outlines proposed changes to the LGPS regulations in England and Wales. It covers 4 areas relating to access to the scheme and its benefits as follows:

- Normal minimum pension age
- Pension access for councillors and mayors
- Academies in the LGPS
- New Fair Deal

Please share our <u>Scheme Improvements (Access and Protections) consultation news item</u> with your LGPS eligible members to make them aware of this consultation.

If you and your members wish to respond to the consultation, MHCLG's preferred method is by their online survey.

The consultation is open until 22 December 2025.
